Senate Bill No. 101

(BY MR. LOVE)

[Passed February 28, 1949; in effect July 1, 1949.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section twelve, article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the allowance of expenses by county courts to sheriffs and their deputies.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twelve, article seven, chapter seven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the allowance of expenses by county courts to sheriffs and their deputies, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 12. *Allowance for Expenses of Sheriff.*—The
2 county court shall allow the actual and necessary ex-

3 penses incurred or expended by the sheriff in arresting,
4 pursuing, or transporting persons accused or convicted of
5 crimes and offenses, including the cost of law enforcement
6 and safety equipment, and in conveying or transferring
7 any person to or from any state institution to which he
8 may be committed from his county, where by law the
9 sheriff is authorized to convey or transfer such person,
10 and shall allow the actual and necessary expenses in-
11 curred or expended in serving summonses, notices, or
12 other official papers in connection with the sheriff's of-
13 fice, including an allowance of seven cents per mile for
14 each mile a sheriff or deputy sheriff is required to drive
15 his personally owned car in the performance of his duties
16 hereunder. Every sheriff shall file monthly, under oath,
17 a full and accurate account of all his actual and necessary
18 expenses mentioned in this section, supported by verified
19 accounts for his deputies for amounts expended or in-
20 curred by each, before payment thereof shall be allowed
21 by the county court.
