## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 62

(BY MR. JOHNSTON, MR. PRESIDENT)

[Passed February 15, 1949; in effect July 1, 1949.]

A BILL to amend and reenact section three, article five-A, chapter twenty-six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the maintenance and treatment of patients in state tuberculosis institutions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article five-A, chapter twenty-six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### Article 5-A. Tuberculosis Control.

Section 3. Maintenance and Treatment of Patients.— 2 The cost of maintenance and treatment of patients ad-3 mitted to state tuberculosis institutions shall be paid out 4 of funds appropriated for the respective institutions. No
5 patient shall be required to pay for such maintenance
6 and treatment, but the institutions are authorized to
7 receive any voluntary payments therefor.
