House Bill No. 112

(By MR. KNIGHT)

[Passed March 3, 1959; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section fourteen, relating to license plates for amateur radio station operators.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article ten, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section fourteen, to read as follows:

Section 14. *License Plate for Amateur Radio Station*

2 *Operators; Regulations.*—Any owner of a motor vehicle
3 who is a resident of the state of West Virginia, and who
4 holds an unrevoked and unexpired official amateur radio
5 station license and/or amateur class operators' license

6 issued by the federal communications commission, upon
7 application, accompanied by proof of ownership of such
8 amateur radio station license, complying with the motor
9 vehicle laws of the state relative to registration and
10 licensing of motor vehicles, and upon payment of the
11 registration, license and other fees required by law, and
12 the payment of the additional special fee herein provided,
13 shall be issued a license plate for a private passenger car,
14 upon which, in lieu of the registration number prescribed
15 by law, shall be inscribed the official amateur radio call
16 letters of such applicant as assigned by the federal com-
17 munications commission.

18 The special fee that shall be charged each applicant
19 for the issuance of a license plate bearing the official
20 amateur radio call letters, in lieu of a registration number,
21 shall be five dollars, which special fee shall be in addition
22 to all other fees required by law. This special fee is for
23 the purpose of compensating the department of motor
24 vehicles for additional costs and services required in the
25 issuing of such licenses.

26 The commissioner is authorized to prescribe proper

27 forms to be used in making application for the special
28 license plates authorized by this section.
