## House Bill No. 388

(By Mr. Speaker, Mr. Pauley, and Mr. Seibert)

[Passed March 4, 1959; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section two, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the collection and expenditure of athletic receipts at state educational institutions.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section two, article one-a, chapter twenty-five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 2. Fees and Money Derived from Athletic Con-

- 2 tests; Collection and Expenditure Thereof.—The directors
- 3 of athletics at state educational institutions may fix and
- 4 charge admission fees to athletic contests at state edu-
- 5 cational institutions and may enter into contracts, spend
- 6 and receive money under such contracts for the student

- 7 athletic teams of state educational institutions to contest
- 8 with other athletic teams inside or outside the state.
- 9 All money derived from such fees and under such con-
- 10 tracts shall be used to defray the cost of maintaining the
- 11 athletic department and athletic program of such insti-
- 12 tutions. The operation of training camps and training
- 13 tables for participants in the athletic program of such
- 14 institutions shall be recognized and considered as a proper
- 15 part of such maintenance, but the specific mention of
- 16 training camps and training tables shall not be construed
- 17 or understood to limit in any way the general power and
- 18 authority otherwise granted and conferred by this section.
