[Passed March 13, 1959; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article one, chapter twenty-four-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the regulation by the public service commission of motor carriers of persons and property for hire and exempting from the provisions of said chapter motor vehicles operated for certain purposes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article one, chapter twenty-four-a of the

code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. Exemptions.—The provisions of this chapter,2 except where specifically otherwise provided, shall not3 apply to:

4 (1) Motor vehicles operated exclusively in the trans5 portation of United States mail or in the transportation
6 of newspapers;

7 (2) Motor vehicles owned and operated by the United 8 States of America, the state of West Virginia, or any county, municipality, or county board of education, or by 9 any department thereof, and any motor vehicles operated 10 under a contract with a county board of education ex-11 12 clusively for the transportation of children to and from 13 school or such other legitimate transportation for the 14 schools as the commission may specifically authorize;

(3) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation of agricultural or horticultural products, livestock,
poultry, and dairy products from the farm or orchard on
which they are raised or produced to markets, processing
plants, packing houses, canneries, railway shipping points,

3 20 and cold storage plants, and in the transportation of agricultural or horticultural supplies to such farms or 21 22 orchards to be used thereon;

23 (4) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation of human or animal excreta; 24

25 (5) Motor vehicles used exclusively in ambulance serv-26 ice; and

27 (6) Motor vehicles used exclusively for volunteer fire 28 department service.

29 (7) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation of coal from mining operations to loading facilities 30 for further shipment by rail or water carriers. 31
