[Passed February 11, 1960; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article seventeen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section designated section four-a, relating to the ultimate liability for excise tax imposed on the sale of cigarettes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article seventeen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section designated section four-a, to read as follows:

Section 4-a. *Ultimate Liability for Tax.*—Every whole-
2 saler, distributor, jobber, or retailer who advances or pays

3 the tax imposed by this article through the purchase of
4 such stamps shall add the amount of the tax so advanced
5 or paid to the price of the cigarettes sold, it being intended
6 that the ultimate incidence of and the liability for the
7 tax shall be upon the ultimate consumer or user.
