AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article three, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to assistants to the attorney general.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article three, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. Assistants to Attorney General.—The attor-2 ney general may appoint such assistant attorneys general 3 as may be necessary to properly perform the duties of 4 his office. The total compensation of all such assistants 5 shall be within the limits of the amounts appropriated by 6 the Legislature for personal services. All assistant attor-7 neys general so appointed shall serve at the pleasure of Enr. H. B. No. 225]

8 the attorney general and shall perform such duties as he

9 may require of them.

10 All laws or parts of laws inconsistent with the provisions11 hereof are hereby amended to be in harmony with the12 provisions of this section.
