
[Passed March 6, 1961; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT directing the state auditor to transfer certain accrued balance in the county, district, and municipal fund to the general revenue fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. *Transfer of Balance in County, District and*
2 *Municipal Fund.*—A balance in the county, district, and
3 municipal fund has been carried for several years on the
4 state financial records, and since there is no practical rea-
5 son for carrying said balance upon the state financial
6 records, effective upon passage of this bill, the state auditor
7 shall transfer from the county, district, and municipal
8 fund, Account 7306, to the general revenue fund, the sum
9 of forty-eight thousand six hundred twenty-two dollars
10 and thirty cents.


