

ENROLLED House Bill No. 552

(By Mr. NUZUM)

[Passed March 9, 1963; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section sixteen, article thirteen-a, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the jurisdiction of justices of the peace for the trials of misdemeanors under the store license law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen, article thirteen-a, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 16. Criminal Liability for Violation of Pro-2 visions of Article; Jurisdiction.—Any person who violates Enr. H. B. No. 552]

3 any of the provisions of this article shall be guilty of a
4 misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined
5 not less than twenty-five dollars nor more than one hun6 dred dollars and each and every day that such violation
7 shall continue shall constitute a separate and distinct of8 fense. Justices of the peace shall have concurrent juris9 diction with any other courts having jurisdiction for the
10 trial of all misdemeanors arising under this section.
