AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article twentyfour, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the powers and duties of the West Virginia historic commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article twenty-four, chapter seventeen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 3. Powers and Duties of Commission; Assist-2 ance of State Road Commission; Acceptance of Gifts, 3 Donations, Contributions, Bequests or Devises.—The comEnr. S. B. No. 67]

4 mission shall be authorized and empowered to purchase 5 new road markers, replace old road markers, protect, preserve and display the Fairfax stones, purchase markers 6 7 for new highways, and, with the consent of the West 8 Virginia turnpike commission, for the West Virginia turnpike; and formulate and write appropriate copy for such 9 markers. The commission is authorized to purchase 10 markers from any commercial company dealing in or 11 manufacturing such markers. The commission shall 12choose the location of such historic road markers, and the 13 state road commission shall have the responsibility for 14 the actual physical placement and repainting thereof. 15 The cost of such placement and repainting shall be paid 16out of the appropriation of the commission. 17

The commission shall also be authorized and em-18 powered, acting through its executive officer and with 19 20 the consent of the governor, to accept and receive gifts, donations, contributions, bequests or devises of money, 2122security or property, both real and personal, or any interest in such property, and said commission may accept, 2324 receive and administer same subject to any terms, limita-25tions or restrictions placed thereupon by the donor.
