## ENROLLED Senate Bill No. 10

(By MR. CARSON, Mr. President, and MR. MORELAND)

[Passed January 24, 1966; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to repeal section seven, article three, chapter five-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the preference to be given by the director of the purchasing division in the purchasing of commodities and printing to commodities and printing produced in this state and to commodities and printing produced and offered for sale by nonprofit workshops as that term is defined.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Repeal of Section Relating to the Preference 2 to Be Given by the Director of the Division of Purchases 3 to State Products and Nonprofit Workshop Products.— Enr. S. B. No. 10]

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4 That section seven, article three, chapter five-a of the
5 code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty6 one, as amended, be repealed.
