AN ACT to amend article two, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section forty-six-b, relating to resident trout fishing license; collection of fee and use of proceeds.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section forty-six-b, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-46b. Class D resident trout fishing license.

1 A Class D license shall be a resident statewide trout fishing
2 license and shall entitle the licensee to fish for trout in all
3 counties of the state, except as prohibited by rules or regula-
4 tions of the director. It shall be issued only to citizens of the
5 United States who are residents of this state.

6 The fee shall be three dollars. The revenue derived from
7 the sale of this license shall be deposited in the state treasury
8 and credited to the department of natural resources and shall

9 be used and paid out, upon order of the director, for state
10 trout hatchery production.

11 This license shall be issued in the form of a stamp prescribed
12 by the director, shall be in addition to a Class AB or B
13 license and shall be valid only when affixed thereto.
