


[Passed April 10, 1981; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section nineteen, article two, chapter fifty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the compensation of commissioners in eminent domain proceedings.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section nineteen, article two, chapter fifty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. PROCEDURE.

§54-2-19. Compensation of commissioners and jurors.

- Each commissioner shall receive as compensation for 1 2 services in each eminent domain proceeding a reasonable 3 amount to be fixed by an order entered of record in the proceeding, said compensation not to exceed the sum of fifty 4 5 dollars per day to be taxed as a part of the costs of the 6 proceeding. The jurors shall receive the same compensation fixed by 7
- 8 law for jurors in felony cases, to be taxed as a part of the costs
- **9** of the proceeding.
