

AN ACT to amend article two, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section forty- four, relating to free fishing days.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article two, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section forty-four to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-44. Free fishing days.

The director may designate up to two days each year as free sport fishing days. On a designated free fishing day, an individual is entitled to fish for all legal fish in all counties of the state without having a Class B, Class F, Class I or Class O license and without the payment of any license fee, subject to the same privileges and restrictions applicable to a holder of any such license.
