AN ACT to amend and reenact section five-b, article three, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to removing the requirement that a copy of the state fire code and amendments to the code be filed with each county clerk.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five-b, article three, chapter twenty-nine of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. FIRE PREVENTION AND CONTROL ACT.

§29-3-5b. Promulgation of rules, regulations, and statewide building code.

- 1 (a) The state fire commission shall promulgate and
- 2 repeal rules and regulations to safeguard life and
- $3\,$ property and to ensure the quality of construction of
- 4 all structures erected or renovated throughout this
- 5 state pursuant to the provisions of chapter twenty-
- 6 nine-a of this code through the adoption of a state
- 7 building code. Such rules, regulations, amendments, or
- $8\,$ repeals thereof shall be in accordance with standard

- 9 safe practices so embodied in widely recognized 10 standards of good practice for building construction 11 and all aspects related thereto and shall have force and 12 effect in those counties and municipalities adopting 13 the state building code.
- 14 (b) Pursuant to the provisions of chapter twenty15 nine-a of this code, on the first day of July, one
 16 thousand nine hundred eighty-eight, the state fire
 17 commission shall commence promulgation of compre18 hensive rules and regulations regarding building
 19 construction, renovation, and all other aspects as
 20 related to the construction and mechanical operations
 21 of a structure. Upon the completion of the promulga22 tion of the rules and regulations, such rules and
 23 regulations shall be known as the "State Building
 24 Code".
- 25 (c) For the purpose of this section the term "building 26 code" is intended to include all aspects of safe building 27 construction and mechanical operations and all safety aspects related thereto: Provided, That the state fire 28 29 marshal shall provide compliance alternatives for 30 historic structures and sites as provided for in section five, article one of this chapter, which compliance 31 32 alternatives shall take into account the historic integ-33 rity of said historic structures and sites. Whenever any other state law, county or municipal ordinance or 34 35 regulation of any agency thereof is more stringent or imposes a higher standard than is required by the 36 37 state fire code, the provisions of such state law, county 38 or municipal ordinance or regulation of any agency 39 thereof shall govern, provided they are not inconsis-40 tent with the laws of West Virginia and are not 41 contrary to recognized standards and good engineering 42 practices. In any question, the decision of the state fire 43 commission determines the relative priority of any 44 such state law, county or municipal ordinance or 45 regulation of any agency thereof and determines compliance with state fire regulations by officials of 46 47 the state, counties, municipalities and political subdivisions of the state. 48
 - (d) Enforcement of the provisions of the state

- 50 building code is the responsibility of the respective 51 local jurisdiction. Also, any county or municipality 52 may enter into an agreement with any other county or 53 municipality to provide inspection and enforcement
- 53 municipality to provide inspection and enforcement 54 services.
- 55 (e) After the state fire commission has promulgated 56 rules and regulations as provided herein, each county 57 or municipality intending to adopt the state building 58 code shall notify the state fire commission of its intent.
- The state fire commission may conduct public meetings in each county or municipality adopting the state building code to explain the provisions of such

62 rules and regulations.
