[Passed March 10, 1990; to take effect July 1, 1990.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to scheduling governmental agencies or programs for termination pursuant to the West Virginia sunset law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article ten, chapter four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 10. THE WEST VIRGINIA SUNSET LAW.

§4-10-4. Termination of governmental entities or programs.

1 The following governmental entities and programs
2 shall be terminated on the date indicated but no
3 governmental entity or program shall be terminated
4 under this article unless a performance audit has been
5 conducted of such entity or program, except as auth-
6 orized under section fourteen of this article:

7 (1) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
8 hundred eighty-one: Judicial council of West Virginia;
9 motor vehicle certificate appeal board; child welfare
10 licensing board.

11 (2) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
12 hundred eighty-two: Ohio River basin commission;
13 commission on postmortem examination; state com-
14 mission on manpower, training and technology.

15 (3) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
16 hundred eighty-three: Anatomical board; economic
17 opportunity advisory committee; community develop-
18 ment authority board.

19 (4) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
20 hundred eighty-four: The following programs of the
21 department of natural resources: Rabies control, work
22 incentive program; West Virginia alcoholic beverage
23 control licensing advisory board.

24 (5) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
25 hundred eighty-five: Beautification commission; labor
26 management advisory council.

27 (6) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
28 hundred eighty-six: Health resources advisory council.

29 (7) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
30 hundred eighty-seven: Civil service commission advi-
31 sory board; council of finance and administration; and
32 the motorcycle safety standards and specifications
33 board.

34 (8) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
35 hundred eighty-eight: Veteran's council; labor man-
36 agement relations board; records management and
37 preservation advisory committee; minimum wage rate
38 board; commission on mass transportation; and the
39 public employees insurance board.

40 (9) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
41 hundred eighty-nine: Mental retardation advisory
42 committee; board of school finance; veteran's affairs
43 advisory council; reclamation commission.

44 (10) On the first day of July, one thousand nine

45 hundred ninety: Consumer affairs advisory council;
46 savings and loan association; forest industries indus-
47 trial foundation; and drivers' license advisory board.

48 (11) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
49 hundred ninety-one: State advisory council of the
50 department of employment security; department of
51 health and human services; oil and gas conservation
52 commission; the family law masters system; state
53 lottery commission; the department of commerce,
54 labor and environmental resources; West Virginia
55 health care cost review authority; the following
56 divisions or programs of the department of agricul-
57 ture: Soil conservation committee, rural resource
58 division, meat inspection program; interagency com-
59 mittee on pesticides; pesticides board of review; and
60 the geological and economic survey; women's commis-
61 sion, child advocate office, department of health and
62 human services; the division of corrections; and the
63 office of workers' compensation commissioner.

64 (12) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
65 hundred ninety-two: State water resources board;
66 water resources division, department of natural
67 resources; whitewater advisory board; state board of
68 risk and insurance management; West Virginia's
69 membership in the interstate commission on the
70 Potomac River basin; board of banking and financial
71 institutions; the farm management commission; state
72 building commission; the capitol building commission;
73 the board of examiners in counseling; and the public
74 service commission: *Provided*, That in the case of the
75 public service commission, the performance and fiscal
76 audit required by this article shall be completed and
77 transmitted to the joint committee on government and
78 finance on or before the first day of July, one thou-
79 sand nine hundred ninety-one, in order that the joint
80 committee or its designated subcommittee may review
81 the audit pursuant to the provisions of section one,
82 article one, chapter twenty-four of this code.

83 (13) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
84 hundred ninety-three: Commission on uniform state
85 laws; state structural barriers compliance board; and

86 the oil and gas inspectors examining board.

87 (14) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
88 hundred ninety-four: Ohio River valley water sanita-
89 tion commission; the southern regional education
90 board; real estate commission; the division of labor and
91 the section of archives and history of the division of
92 culture and history.

93 (15) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
94 hundred ninety-five: Emergency medical services
95 advisory council; commission on charitable organiza-
96 tions; information system advisory commission; and
97 the board of social work examiners.

98 (16) On the first day of July, one thousand nine
99 hundred ninety-six: U.S. geological survey program
100 within the division of natural resources; and the board
101 of investments.
