[Passed December 9, 1991; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact sections two and two-b, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to apportionment of membership of the House of Delegates; describing such delegate districts; and requiring that precinct boundaries comport with senatorial and delegate districts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That sections two and two-b, article two, chapter one of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

#### **ARTICLE 2. APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATION.**

## §1-2-2. Apportionment of membership of House of Delegates.

1 (a) This section shall be known and may be cited as 2 "The House of Delegates Apportionment Act of 1991."

3 (b) As used in this section:

4 (1) "County" means the territory comprising a county 5 of this state as it existed on the first day of January,

one thousand nine hundred eighty, notwithstanding anyboundary changes made subsequent thereto;

(2) "Block," "block group," "census tract," "place" and 8 "voting district" mean those geographic areas as defined 9 by the bureau of the census of the United States 1011department of commerce for the taking of the one 12thousand nine hundred ninety census of population and 13described on census maps prepared by the bureau of the 14 census. Such maps are, at the time of this enactment, 15maintained by the bureau of the census and filed in the 16office of legislative services;

17 (3) "Magisterial district" means the territory compris-18 ing a magisterial district of this state as reported to and 19 used by the bureau of the census of the United States 20 department of commerce for the taking of the one 21 thousand nine hundred ninety census of population and 22 described on census maps prepared by the bureau of the 23 census;



# §1-2-2b. Precinct boundary changes.

1 If an election precinct of this state includes territory  $\mathbf{2}$ contained in more than one senatorial or delegate 3 district, as such senatorial districts are established by subsection (d), section one of this article, and as such 4  $\mathbf{5}$ delegate districts are established by subsection (c), 6 section two of this article, it shall be the duty of the  $\overline{7}$ county commission of the county in which such precinct 8 is located, prior to the fifteenth day of March, one 9 thousand nine hundred ninety-two, to alter the boundary 10lines of its election precincts so that no precinct contains 11 territory included in more than one senatorial or 12delegate district. The provisions of this section shall govern and control notwithstanding any conflicting 13provision of section seven, article one, chapter three of 14 15this code.
