AN ACT to amend and reenact section twelve, article one, chapter ten of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to additional membership on the West Virginia library commission; the composition of the membership; and requiring geographic representation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section twelve, article one, chapter ten of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. PUBLIC LIBRARIES.

§10-1-12. State library commission.

- 1 There shall be a state library commission, known as the
- 2 "West Virginia library commission", which shall consist
- 3 of five members who shall be appointed by the governor,
- 4 by and with the advice and consent of the Senate, each

5 for a term of four years. Thereafter, on the first day of
6 July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-five, four
7 additional members shall be appointed: *Provided*, That
8 for the four new members added to the commission in
9 the year one thousand nine hundred ninety-five, one
10 shall serve an initial term of four years and three shall
11 serve an initial term of two years. No more than three
12 members may reside in the same congressional district.
13 At least four members of the commission shall be women
14 and at least four members shall be men. No member of
15 the commission shall receive compensation for services
16 rendered, nor be engaged or interested in the publishing
17 business.

18 The members of the commission in office on the date
19 this code takes effect shall, unless sooner removed,
20 continue to serve until their respective terms expire and
21 their successors have been appointed and have qualified.
22 On or before the expiration of the terms for which said
23 members are appointed, the governor shall appoint their
24 successors.
