[Passed March 13, 1998; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to abolishing transfer of funds from barbers and cosmetologists fund to the general revenue fund; and clarifying that the fund is subject to legislative appropriation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fourteen, article twenty-seven, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 27. BOARD OF BARBERS AND COSMETOLOGISTS.

§30-27-14. Collections and expenditures; disposition of funds.

1 All money collected under the provisions of this article
2 shall be deposited in the state treasury as provided by law,
3 and shall be credited to the board of barbers and beauti-
4 cians in a special fund that has been known as the "bar-
5 bers and beauticians special fund" and is hereby continued
6 and shall be designated the "barbers and cosmetologists
7 fund". All money in such fund shall be expended only for
8 the administration and enforcement of the provisions of
9 this article and are not authorized from collections but are
10 to be made only in accordance with appropriation by the
11 Legislature and in accordance with the provisions of
12 article three, chapter twelve of this code and upon the
13 fulfillment of the provisions set forth in article two,
14 chapter five-a of this code: *Provided*, That for the fiscal
15 year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine
16 hundred ninety-eight, expenditures are authorized from
17 collections rather than pursuant to an appropriation by
18 the Legislature. Amounts collected which are found from
19 time to time to exceed the funds needed for purposes set
20 forth in this article may be transferred to other accounts
21 or funds and redesignated for other purposes by appropri-
22 ation of the Legislature.
