AN ACT to amend and reenact section thirty, article twentythree, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the racing commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section thirty, article twenty-three, chapter nineteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 23. HORSE AND DOG RACING.

§19-23-30. Termination of the racing commission.

- 1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
- 2 this code, the racing commission shall continue to exist
- 3 until the first day of July, two thousand.
