## Senate Bill No. 455

(SENATORS MINARD AND UNGER, original sponsors)

[Passed March 7, 2003; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article ten, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section fifteen-b, relating to authorizing service credit toward retirement to public employees for public employment in another state.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article ten, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section fifteen-b, to read as follows:

#### ARTICLE 10. WEST VIRGINIA PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT.

### §5-10-15b. Credit for public employment in another state.

- 1 (a) Any member of the retirement system who has
- 2 previously been employed in public employment in any
- 3 other state of the United States is entitled to receive
- 4 credited service for the time of public employment in that

- state, not to exceed five years, if the member substantiates
- by appropriate documentation or evidence his or her
- public employment in another state and makes contribu-
- tions as required: Provided, That the employee is not
- entitled to receive the credited service if the employee is
- 10 vested or entitled to be vested in a retirement system of the
- state in which the employment credit was earned and the 11
- 12 employee is entitled to service credit in that retirement
- 13 system for the employment period for which the applicant
- seeks credited service in West Virginia: Provided, however, 14
- 15 That the service credit from the other state may not be
- 16 used to meet West Virginia's eligibility requirements for
- 17 retirement or vesting.
- 18 Employees entitled to out-of-state service credit under
- 19 the provisions of this section shall make additional
- 20 contribution to the retirement system equal to the actuar-
- 21 ial equivalent of the amount which would have been

- 24 covered during the period of the retroactive service credit.
