AN ACT to amend §5-14-4 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to correcting the statutory inconsistency of appointments to the commission for the deaf and hard-of-hearing in relation to the terms and number of appointees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That §5-14-4 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 14. WEST VIRGINIA COMMISSION FOR THE DEAF AND  
HARD-OF-HEARING.**

**§5-14-4. Terms of office; quorum.**

1 Members of the commission who do not serve ex officio  
2 shall be appointed for the following terms: Three members  
3 shall be appointed for a term of three years; three for a  
4 term of two years; and three for a term of one year. When  
5 a vacancy occurs, an appointment shall be made for the  
6 unexpired term. The members shall annually elect a

7 chairman. A majority of the members constitutes a  
8 quorum for the transaction of business.
