AN ACT to amend and reenact §16-5Q-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuation of the James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §16-5Q-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5Q. THE JAMES "TIGER" MORTON CATASTROPHIC ILL-NESS FUND.

§16-5Q-3. James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Commission continued.

Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of this
code, the James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Commis sion shall continue to exist until the first day of July, two
thousand eight, unless sooner terminated, continued or reestab lished.
