ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 118)

[Passed March 14, 1931; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and re-enact chapter twenty, article three, section thirteen of the official code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That chapter twenty, article three, section thirteen, of the official code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to bounties for killing wild nongame animals, be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

Section 13. The commission shall have the authority to offer and pay, from time to time, under such regulations as are hereinafter prescribed, such bounties for the killing and destruction of wild nongame animals which prey upon and destroy game animals and game, song, and insectivorous wild birds and fowls of this state, as the commission shall deem necessary; and the county courts of the counties of Grant, Greenbrier, Monroe,

 9 in their discretion, upon petition of not less than one hundred
 10 citizens and voters of such counties offer and pay from time to
 11 time under such regulations as they may prescribe, such ad-
 12 ditional bounty as such courts may deem necessary for the kill-
 13 ing and destruction of wild nongame animals and fowls as they
 14 may by order entered of record designate.
