AN ACT to repeal section twelve, article twenty, of chapter nineteen, of the official code of West Virginia, relating to dogs.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That section twelve, article twenty, of chapter 2 nineteen of the code of West Virginia, be repealed, and hereafter 3 be omitted from the sections, language, terms and provisions of 4 the same.
