ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 155)

[Passed March 4, 1931; in effect May 1, 1931.]

AN ACT to amend and re-enact section one, article fifteen, chapter eighteen, of the official code of West Virginia, of one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, relating to New River State School.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article fifteen, chapter eighteen, of the official code of West Virginia be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 1. The New River State School heretofore established and located at Montgomery, in Fayette county, shall be continued and shall be known as the "New River State College." The educational affairs of the school shall be under the control, supervision and management of the state board of education, as provided in section thirteen, article two, of this chapter, and its financial and business affairs shall be under the charge and control of the state board of control, as provided in section four, article one, chapter twenty-five of the code. 10 regulations made by the president and faculty of this institu-
11 tion for its general government shall be submitted to the state
12 board of education for its approval. The college shall offer in-
13 struction in home economics, industrial subjects, and such other
14 subjects as the state board of education may direct.

16 pealed.
