# ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 29)

[Passed March 11, 1931; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and re-enact section four of article five of chapter eighteen of the official code of West Virginia, relating to district boards of education and their compensation.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section four of article five of chapter eighteen of the official code of West Virginia, be and the same is amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 4. The district board of education shall hold its regular meetings on the first Monday in July, the second and fourth Tuesdays in August, and, when the schools are in session, on the fourth Saturday of each calendar month or other regular days in the fourth week of the month to be agreed upon by the board, all such meetings to be held at a place to be designated by the board at its first meeting held on the first Monday in July in each year. 9 two school commissioners, boards of education may hold other  
10 meetings, but no business shall be transacted at any called meet-  
11 ing except such as may be designated in the call therefor, of  
12 which all the members have had notice.

13 A majority of all the members of a board of education shall  
14 constitute a quorum and such board shall not transact any official  
15 business except when assembled as a board.

15a Each member of a board of education shall be entitled to re-  
15b ceive, as compensation for his service, three dollars a day for  
16 each day spent in the performance of his official duties: *Pro-*  
17 *vided, however,* That no president of a board of education shall  
18 receive pay for more than fifteen days, and no commissioner  
19 shall receive pay for more than twelve days, in any year: *Pro-*  
20 *vided further,* That in districts employing two hun-  
21 dred teachers or more, in counties having a population of more  
22 than one hundred fifty thousand, the president of a board of  
23 education shall be entitled to receive, as compensation for his  
24 services, five hundred dollars per annum, and in districts em-  
25 ploying two hundred teachers or more, each member of a board  
26 of education shall be entitled to receive, as compensation for his  
27 services, the sum of four hundred dollars per annum.

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28 All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby  
29 repealed.
