ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 310)

[Passed March 13, 1931, in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT relating to the salaries of prosecuting attorneys in the counties of Raleigh and Mercer.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. Beginning January first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, the annual compensation of the prosecuting attorney of Raleigh county shall be fixed and paid monthly by the county court of said county and shall be not less than two thousand four hundred dollars and not more than four thousand dollars. Beginning January first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, the annual compensation of the prosecuting attorney of Mercer county shall be fixed and paid monthly by the county court of said county and shall not be less than two thousand four hundred dollars nor more than four thousand five hundred dollars.

All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
