ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 321)

[Passed March 4, 1931; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing and empowering the county court of Wetzel county to lay a special levy for the purpose of purchasing rights-of-way along designated state routes within said county of Wetzel.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Wetzel county is hereby 2 authorized and empowered and directed to lay a levy, in addition to all other levies, on all the taxable property in said Wetzel 3 county, for a period of five years beginning with the year one 4 thousand nine hundred thirty-one, of ten cents on each one 5 hundred dollars of the assessed valuation of said Wetzel county, 6 for the purpose of purchasing rights-of-way along designated 7 state routes within said county of Wetzel, and for no other purpose. 8 9
