ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 351)

[Passed March 14, 1931; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to provide funds for the relief of persons who, by act of Providence or otherwise, are in needy or necessitous circumstances, by authorizing municipalities to transfer money from other funds to the general fund for the fiscal years beginning July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty and July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, and to make contracts, incur indebtedness and issue orders therefor payable out of the general fund for the fiscal year one thousand, nine hundred and thirty-one, prior to the beginning of such fiscal year.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That for the relief of persons who, by act of Providence or otherwise, are in needy or necessitous circumstances, the council or other governing body of any municipality, in addition to authority already provided by statute, is hereby authorized and empowered: (1) To transfer, during the fiscal year beginning the first day of July, nineteen hundred

7 and thirty, from any fund under its control, except funds de-  
8 rived from levies authorized by a vote of the people, to the gen-  
9 eral fund, a sum not exceeding ten cents on each one hundred  
10 dollars of the nineteen hundred and thirty assessed valuation of  
11 all property of the municipality; (2) To transfer, from any fund  
12 under its control, except funds derived from levies authorized  
13 by vote of the people, to the general fund, a sum not exceeding  
14 ten cents on each one hundred dollars of the assessed valuation  
15 of all property of the municipality, during the fiscal year begin-  
16 ning the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-  
17 one; (3) To, at any time during the fiscal year ending the thir-  
18 tieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one,  
19 enter into contract, incur indebtedness and issue orders for the  
20 relief of the needy, payable in an amount not to exceed five cents  
21 on each one hundred dollars of the nineteen hundred and thirty  
22 assessed valuation of the property of the municipality out of the  
23 general fund for the fiscal year beginning the first day of July,  
24 one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one: *Provided, however,*  
25 That the orders to be issued, indebtedness incurred and con-  
26 tracts entered into as provided in subsection three hereof, shall  
27 be administered, distributed and controlled only under the di-

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28 rection of the American Red Cross in municipalities where  
29 chapters of such organization exist.
