ENROLLED BILL

House Bill No. 352.

(By Mr. Reynolds of Mineral)

Passed March 14, 1931

In Effect from Passage

Section 1. That for the relief of persons who, by act of Providence or otherwise, are in needy or necessitous circumstances, the county courts of the several counties of the state in addition to authority already provided by statute are hereby authorized and empowered:

6 (1) To transfer during the fiscal year beginning the first
7 day of July, one thousand nine hundred thirty, from the county
8 road fund to the general county fund, a sum not exceeding ten
9 cents on each one hundred dollars of the nineteen hundred
10 thirty assessed valuation of all property of the county:
11 *Provided, however,* That where the transfer of money from the
12 county road fund to the general county fund for the fiscal year
13 beginning the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred
14 thirty, has already been authorized in any county by a special
15 act of the legislature for the purposes set forth in this section,
16 the same shall be credited against the total amount authorized
17 to be transferred by subparagraph (1) of section one of this
18 article.

19 (2) To transfer from the county road fund to the general
20 county fund, a sum not exceeding ten cents on each one hundred
21 dollars of the assessed valuation of all property of the county,
22 during the fiscal year beginning the first day of July one thou-
23 sand nine hundred thirty-one.

24 (3) To, at any time during the fiscal year ending the thir-
25 tieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, enter
26 into contracts, incur indebtedness and issue orders for the

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27 relief of the needy, payable in an amount not to exceed five
28 cents on each one hundred dollars of the nineteen hundred
29 thirty assessed valuation of all property of the county out of
30 the general county fund for the fiscal year beginning the first
31 day of July, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one.
