## ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 44)

[Passed January 30, 1931; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and re-enact section four of chapter eighty-three of the acts of one thousand eight hundred seventy-one, entitled: "An act to provide free schools for the district of Elizabeth, in the county of Wirt," passed February twenty-one, one thousand eight hundred seventy-one.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section four of chapter eighty-three of the acts of one thousand eight hundred seventy-one be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 4. The qualified voters of said school district of Elizabeth, shall, on the second Monday in April of each year, elect one commissioner, and the elections shall be conducted by three voters of said district selected by the board of education thereof in conjunction with the council of the town of Elizabeth, and the ex-
