AN ACT to amend and re-enact section seven of article six of chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, relating to game, fish and forestry.


Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven of article six of chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, relating to game, fish and forestry, be amended and re-enacted so as to read as follows:

Section 7. The commission may establish, operate, conduct and -2 maintain fish hatcheries and feeding stations for fish, and may 3 employ and appoint such persons and assistants at such salaries 4 and for such time as it may deem necessary to operate, conduct 5 and care for them, and may discharge such employees and 6 appointees at will. It may, in the name of the state, purchase 7 or lease lands and water necessary for the establishment, opera-
