8 260; section 500, title 16, of the Code of Laws of the United
9 States of America). Where the national forest is situated in
10 more than one county the money shall be distributed in pro-
11 portion to the area of the national forest situated in the respec-
12 tive counties interested, and to that end the state auditor is
13 hereby authorized and required to obtain the necessary infor-
14 mation to enable him to make the distribution on such basis.
15 It shall also be the duty of the state auditor, upon the payment
16 of such moneys to the sheriffs of the respective counties, to
17 report such payments to the county courts of the respective
18 counties.

Sec. 2. The county courts of the respective counties to which
2 the money is distributed are hereby authorized and directed to
3 distribute and expend said moneys for the benefit of the public
4 schools and public roads in the districts of the respective coun-
5 ties in proportion to the area of the national forest situated in
6 the respective districts interested, and not otherwise, and to
7 that end the county courts of the respective counties are author-
8 ized and required to obtain the necessary information to enable
9 them to make the distribution on such basis.
