# ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 222)

[Passed March 12, 1931; in effect *ninety days* from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Grafton independent school district of Taylor county, to purchase fractional interests in a building for physical education or other educational purposes and to lease outstanding interests therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of Grafton independent school district of Taylor county is hereby authorized and empowered to acquire by purchase, or otherwise, a one-third or other fractional undivided interest in and to a building in said

16 to acquire and own options covering the rights to purchase the  
17 outstanding interest or interests heretofore mentioned in such
