


[Passed June 3, 1933; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section ten, chapter twelve, acts of the legislature of West Virginia, extraordinary session, one thousand nine hundred thirty-two, providing for the distraint of goods and chattels for taxes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section ten, chapter twelve, acts of the legislature of West Virginia, extraordinary session one thousand nine hundred thirtytwo, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

Section 10. Any goods or chattels in the county belonging 2 to the person or estate assessed with taxes which are due and 3 payable, may be distrained therefor after the last day of Novem-4 ber in the year for which the taxes were assessed, as to all taxes 5 falling due on the first day of November of such year, and after 6 the last day of May of the year following, as to all taxes falling





7 due on the first day of May following the year in which the8 taxes were assessed; or before either of such dates if such goods9 or chattels are about to be removed from the county.

• 10 All acts or parts of acts in conflict herewith are hereby re-11 pealed.
