ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 170)

[Passed May 24, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the city of Keyser in the county of Mineral, West Virginia, to borrow funds from the reconstruction finance corporation, or other federal agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing a municipal building and swimming pool in said city, and to give a lien or liens to secure the same upon the lot upon which said municipal building and swimming pool shall be constructed and upon the improvements thereon.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the city of Keyser in the county of Mineral,
2 West Virginia, is hereby authorized to borrow funds from the
3 reconstruction finance corporation, or other federal agency
4 authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing a
5 municipal building and swimming pool in said city, and to give
