ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 212)

[Passed June 3, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the board of education of Fork Lick district, Webster county, West Virginia, to transfer funds from the new building and improvement fund, the elementary maintenance fund and the high school maintenance fund to the high school teachers' and the elementary teachers' funds in said district.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the board of education of Fork Lick district, 2 Webster county, West Virginia, is authorized and empowered 3 to transfer from the new building and improvement fund to 4 the high school teachers' fund of said district, not to exceed the 5 sum of one thousand two hundred dollars from the high school 6 maintenance fund to the high school teachers' fund of said 7 district not to exceed the sum of two thousand three hundred
