ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 215)

[Passed June 3, 1933: in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend the charter of the town of Circleville, Pendleton county, West Virginia, if and when incorporated, authorizing the council of the town of Circleville to erect a water power plant, to borrow the funds to pay the cost of construction from the reconstruction finance corporation, or other source, on the self liquidating basis, and to execute a lien or liens upon the plant and upon the lot upon which it shall be erected.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the charter of the town of Circleville, if and when incorporated, be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 2. The council of the town of Circleville shall have power to erect a water power plant for such purposes as shall be designated by the council. The council shall have power to borrow a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate fifteen thousand

6 source, to be used to pay the cost of construction and of the
7 land upon which the building shall be erected, and may execute
8 a lien or liens upon such land and plant to secure payment of
9 such loan or loans and may do any and all other things required
10 by the reconstruction finance corporation or necessary and
11 proper to obtain such loan or loans, to secure payment thereof
12 and to build and maintain the plant. The council shall make
13 provision for the payment of such loan or loans from the income
14 of the plant but in no event shall it incur any indebtedness or
15 issue any evidence of obligation imposing any liability upon the
16 town or its taxpayers with respect thereto or impose any tax or
17 assessment to provide for the payment of such loan or loans.
