ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 220)

[Passed June 3, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the boards of education of Grant district, Kingwood district, Lyon district, Pleasant district, Portland district, Reno district, Union district, and Valley district, of Preston county, to transfer school funds, excepting proceeds of bond issues or moneys raised by levy for the purpose of meeting interest and sinking fund requirements of outstanding bond issues, from any school fund or funds in which there is a balance to any other school fund or funds in which there is a deficit, under their control, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The respective boards of education of Grant district, Kingwood district, Lyon district, Pleasant district, Portland district, Reno district, Union district and Valley district,

4 of Preston county, are hereby authorized to transfer any school
5 fund or funds not ^oneeded to meet the requirements of such fund
6 or funds for the present fiscal year, to the elementary teachers'
7 fund and/or the high school ^oteachers' fund of the said respective
8 districts, for the purpose of paying valid claims for teachers
9 salaries for the current fiscal year ending June thirtieth, one
10 thousand nine hundred thirty-three: *Provided, however,* That
11 no transfer shall be made from the proceeds of bond issues or
12 moneys raised by levy for the purpose of meeting the interest
13 and sinking fund requirements of outstanding bond issues.
