ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 43)

[Passed April 18, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Black Fork dis-
 trict, Tucker county, to erect a gymnasium in the town of Par-
 sons to be used for school and other purposes and to borrow the
 money for building same, in an amount not to exceed three
 thousand dollars, from the reconstruction finance corporation
 and to give a lien or liens to secure the same upon the lot on
 which the said gymnasium will be erected and upon the build-
 ing to be erected thereon and providing that no part of said
 money or interest on same shall be repaid from the proceeds of
 any taxes laid or levied by said board of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. That the board of education of Black Fork dis-
 2 trict, Tucker county, is authorized to borrow from the reconstruc-
 3 tion finance corporation a sum not to exceed three thousand dol-

4 lars to be used in building a gymnasium on property owned by
4-a said board in the town of Parsons, to be used for school and
5 other purposes. Said board is further authorized, for the purpose
6 of securing said loans, to give a lien or liens upon the lot on
7 which said gymnasium is erected and upon the building erected
8 thereon and to do any and all other things required by said re-
9 construction finance corporation or necessary and proper to ob-
10 tain said loan, to secure the same and to build and maintain said
11 building and to carry out the provisions of this act. No part of
12 said sum so borrowed or any interest thereon shall ever be paid
13 from the proceeds of any taxes laid or levied by said board of
14 education.
