ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 50)

[Passed May 18, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of any magisterial district of Pleasants county to transfer funds, except proceeds of bond issues, or money raised by levy for the purpose of meeting the interest and sinking fund requirements of outstanding bond issues, from any school fund or funds to any other school fund or funds, under its control, for the fiscal year ending June thirtieth, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of any magisterial district in the county of Pleasants is authorized to transfer any school fund or funds under its control, except proceeds of bond issues, or monies raised by levy for the purpose of meeting the interest and sinking fund requirements of outstanding bond
