ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 51)

[Passed May 19, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the board of education of Fairfax district, Tucker county, to erect a gymnasium in the town of Thomas to be used for school and other purposes and to borrow the money for building same, in an amount not to exceed four thousand dollars, from the reconstruction finance corporation or other federal governmental agencies, and to give a lien or liens to secure the same upon the lot on which the said gymnasium will be erected and upon the building to be erected thereon, and providing that no part of said money or interest on same shall be repaid from the proceeds of any taxes laid or levied by said board of education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of education of Fairfax district,
2 Tucker county, is authorized to borrow from the reconstruction

4 sum not to exceed four thousand dollars to be used in build-
5 ing a gymnasium on property owned by said board in the town
6 of Thomas, to be used for school and other purposes. Said
7 board is further authorized, for the purpose of securing said
8 loan, or loans, to give a lien or liens on the lot upon which said
9 gymnasium is erected and upon the building erected thereon
10 and to do anything and all things required by said reconstruc-
11 tion finance corporation or other federal governmental agency
12 from which a loan may be obtained, or necessary and proper
13 to obtain said loan, or loans, to secure the same and to build
14 and maintain said building and to carry out the provisions of
15 this act. No part of said sum, or sums, so borrowed, or any
16 interest thereon, shall ever be paid from the proceeds of any
17 taxes laid or levied by said board.
