## ENROLLED BILL

(S. B. No. 52)

[Passed May 18, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize any and all boards of education of Grant county to transfer funds, excepting proceeds of bond issues, or moneys raised by levy for the purpose of meeting the interest and sinking fund requirements of outstanding bond issues, from any school fund or funds to any other school fund or funds, under their control, for the fiscal year ending June thirty, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

Section 1. Any and all boards of education of Grant county  
2 are authorized to transfer any school fund or funds under their  
3 control, excepting proceeds of bond issues, or moneys raised by  
4 levy for the purpose of meeting the interest and sinking fund  
5 requirements of outstanding bond issues, to any other school  
6 fund or funds, for the fiscal year ending June thirty, one  
7 thousand nine hundred thirty-three.
