(S. B. No. 64)

[Passed June 3, 1933; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to extend the time for returning real estate assessed for one thousand nine hundred thirty-two taxes delinquent and relief to taxpayers.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The sheriff or collector, after ascertaining which 2 of the taxes assessed in his county for the year one thousand 3 nine hundred thirty-two cannot be collected, shall, on or before 4 the first Monday in August, one thousand nine hundred thirty-5 three, make out alphabetical lists, by districts of three classes, 6 as provided in (a), (b), and (c) of section twenty, article nine, 7 chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia.
