[Passed January 5, 1934; in effect from passage.]

~~AN ACT~~ to authorize the county court of Berkeley county, West Virginia, to transfer any or all district road funds in the several districts of said county, to the general county fund for the fiscal years beginning July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, and July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-four.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Berkeley county, West Virginia, is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer any or all district road funds in the several districts of said county, to the general county fund for the fiscal years beginning July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-three, and July first, one thousand nine hundred thirty-four.
