ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 212)

[Passed January 11, 1934; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Lewis county, West Virginia, to borrow funds from the public works administration or other federal governmental agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a heating plant; to issue such bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness as may be required by such federal governmental agency; and to promulgate such ordinances as may be necessary for the construction of such plant, and as may be necessary to provide for the amortization and liquidation of such indebtedness.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Lewis county, West Virginia, 2 is hereby authorized to borrow funds from the public works 3 administration or other federal governmental agency authorized 4 to make loans, for the purpose of constructing, equipping and 5 maintaining a heating plant. Said county court is authorized

6 to issue bonds or other evidences of indebtedness as may be
7 required by said public works administration or other federal
8 governmental agency, and do any and all things required by
9 said public works administration or other said governmental
10 agency from which such loan is obtained, or necessary and proper
11 to obtain said loan, to secure the same, and to construct, equip
12 and maintain said heating plant.

Sec. 2. The county court of Lewis county is hereby em-
2 powered to undertake and do all things necessary to carry out
3 the preceding section of this act, to promulgate such ordinances,
4 rules and regulations as may be necessary, and by appropriate
5 action of said board provide for the repayment of said loan
6 and/or amortization of said bonds.
