ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 218)

[Passed January 16, 1934; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize the county court of Greenbrier county, West Virginia, to borrow funds from the public works administration or other federal governmental agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing and equipping a courthouse or county jail, or both; to issue such bonds, or other evidences of indebtedness as may be required by such federal governmental agency; and to promulgate such ordinances as may be necessary for the construction of such courthouse or jail, or both, and as may be necessary to provide for the amortization and liquidation of such indebtedness.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Greenbrier county, West Virginia, is hereby authorized to borrow funds from the public works administration or other federal governmental agency authorized to make loans, for the purpose of constructing, equip-

5 ping and maintaining a courthouse, county jail, or both. Said  
6 county court is authorized to issue bonds, or other evidences of  
7 indebtedness as may be required by said public works admini-  
8 stration or other federal governmental agency, and do any and  
9 all things required by said public works administration or  
10 other said governmental agency from which such loan is ob-  
11 tained, or necessary and proper to obtain said loan, to secure  
12 the same, and to construct, equip and maintain said courthouse  
13 or county jail, or both.

Sec. 2. The county court of Greenbrier county is hereby em-  
2 powered to undertake and do all things necessary to carry out  
3 the preceding section of this act, to promulgate such ordinances,  
4 rules and regulations as may be necessary, and by appropriate  
5 action of said board provide for the repayment of said loan  
6 and/or amortization of said bonds.
