ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 225)

[Passed January 25, 1934; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to authorize and empower the board of commissioners of the county of Ohio to transfer, annually, the unexpended balances in the dog tax fund, to the general county fund of said county.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The board of commissioners of the county of Ohio is hereby authorized and empowered to transfer, annually, the unexpended balances in the dog tax fund of said county, remaining and not needed for the payment and satisfaction of all claims and expenses against the said dog tax fund, to the general county fund of said county.

All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, insofar as they may apply to Ohio county.
