ENROLLED BILL

(H. B. No. 291)

[Passed February 13, 1934; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT authorizing the county court of Wirt county to transfer
a fund arising from collections of prohibition enforcement
fees to the general county fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

Section 1. The county court of Wirt county is hereby given
the right and authority to transfer the sum of three hundred
dollars or more, arising from collections of prohibition en-
forcement fees in said county, now in the hands of the sheriff
and use the same for general county purposes.
